It's free to nominate and all shortlisted nominees will receive two complimentary tickets to an Awards ceremony and celebration in Hull on the afternoon of Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023, and extra tickets can be purchased at £20 per person.

Nominations will open on 1st June 2023 and close on Sunday 23rd July 2023.

$\bigcirc$	Active and Sports Volunteer Award  Recognises a volunteer who encourages people to be physically active, whether it's leading a walking group, serving refreshments at a grassroots football club, or voluntarily organising competitive sports.
0	Behind The Scenes Volunteer Award  This volunteer works quietly in the background but keeps groups and charities going. They don't make a song and dance about their volunteering, so we will!
0	Good Neighbour Volunteer Award  This volunteer makes their neighbourhood or local community a better place. They make people happier and more connected to create a positive community feel.
$\bigcirc$	Environmental Volunteer Award  Someone who volunteers in the natural world, either to protect and preserve it, shout about the importance of it, or to help others experience it.
0	Founding Volunteer Award  Organisations often begin with a founder who had the bravery to make an idea happen. Nominate a volunteer who changed lives when they volunteered to start a group or charity. (This category isn't limited to volunteering in the last 12 months).
0	Inclusive Volunteer Award  This volunteer empowers people to feel included and valued. The winner might work within BAME communities, the LGBTQ+ sector or with people who have a disability.
$\bigcirc$	Older Volunteer Award This award is for a volunteer who is over 75, and whose stamina and commitment to making a difference should be celebrated!
0	Young Volunteer Award This award is for a volunteer who is under 25, has brought energy and enthusiasm, and shown real initiative to do something good.
0	Long-Serving Volunteer Award  This volunteer has dedicated large parts of their life to volunteering. They may have supported many organisations and causes over the years, giving their time year in year out. (This category isn't limited to volunteering in the last 12 months.)
$\bigcirc$	Volunteer Fundraiser Award  This volunteer raises funds for a group or charity, either through formal applications or by going to great lengths to fundraise in their own personal and inventive ways.
$\bigcirc$	Volunteer Trustee Award Recognises an influential Trustee who drives a charitable board and contributes through hard work, skills and commitment.
0	Volunteer Team Award  This award is for a collective of volunteers who work together to change lives. The winning team will be a strong unit who supports each other, as well as the work they do.
